**The N6.285CR2 offers high torque at low revs**

French engine manufacturer Nanni has announced that its N6.285CR2 engine has been chosen by Integrity Boats to power its latest model, the Classic 440 Sedan.

Each year around 10 engines will be produced for the Australian yard.

The Nanni N6.285CR2 was chosen for its large displacement and high torque at low revs (2500 rpm, with six cylinders in line, developing 284hp). This type of power is said to be particularly suitable for the displacement hull of the Classic 440 Sedan model.

Ideal for long distance or coastal cruising, the 13.6m Classic 440 Sedan offers low maintenance, stability and robustness.

Sea trial results show that the vessel reaches a hull speed of 8.5kt at a low rpm (1900 rpm), with a fuel consumption of just 17.4 litres per hour.
